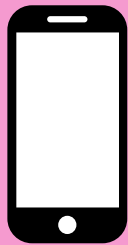

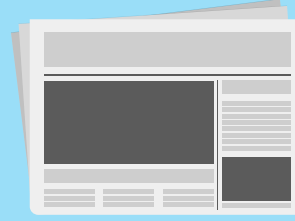

Not all business advertise using online job websites.

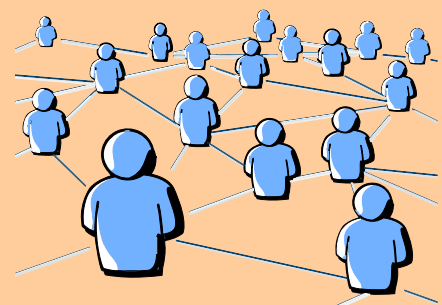
- Look at notice boards in local shops, cafes, libraries and other public places.
- Visit small local business social media accounts/channels.
- Have a look through local/national papers in the job adverts section.



Join a recruitment agency

Recruitment agencies can be a great starting point in your job search.

- They have a range of experts who will be able to provide support & advice around your CV
- Agencies have well established links with employers in many industries and can help arrange interviews.



Networking
