

Through storybook characters pupils learn about the 'World of Work' and the importance of saving, earning, decision making and teamwork.

Session 1: Vishnal's Garden

In this session students will be introduced to all the characters in the story and develop an awareness of the need for co-operation when doing things at school with classmates and at home with family and friends.

Session 2: Polly's Farm

In this session students will understand the concept of work, recognising that farms are one place where goods are produced and can be sold for money. The importance of money being used to satisfy our needs and wants.

Session 3: At the Hospital

In this session students will appreciate there are many different jobs within a hospital. They will also develop an understanding that workers need many different skills and that people earn money when working.

Session 4: The School Caretaker

In this session students will appreciate many jobs need to be done in school and identify that some jobs in school are dangerous and should only be done by adults. They will recognise that they can work together to make their school environment a better place to be. Also in this session students will identify what savings are and the importance of saving.

Session 5: The Adventure Playground

In this session students will realise that people have aims/objectives and appreciate that we can often reach our objectives quicker by working together. Working together can be fun as well as fulfilling. Students will also appreciate that saving can take a long time and understand that people are often faced with difficult choices.
